Notes :

- All rider levies are payable within 7 days of the event to the Treasurer of the Centre in which the event took place, or to the Association Treasurer if promoted by an Association.
- Event Registration Forms & Fees for Non-competitive Social, Charity & Reliability Ride Events should be sent direct to SCU HQ
- For Youth & Under 12 riders and 'New first time' competitors in 'entry-level' events no levy is payable in respect of Byelaw 10.8.1
- 'New first time' competitors in 'entry-level' rides are also exempt from the single event licence fee - for one event only
- All events are covered by Scottish Cycling Technical Regulations
- All insurance premiums are inclusive of Insurance Premium Tax
- 'Part Day' Events are limited to a morning, afternoon or evening
- For Non-Member Events (as per Tech. Reg. 1.10 and 15.12) an insurance premium of £1.50 per competitor is payable
