Course Description: Caithness Cycling Clubs 10 mile TT Shebster course.

Start at the road junction opposite the Recycling Centre 1 mile outside Thurso on the B874. Proceed for 5.19 miles to the turn at the first gate post of the entrance to the house. Retrace 4.81 miles to the finish at the Red Telephone Box just past the Janetstown junction.



Traffic Flows: The course is Out and Back with a Dead Turn.

This course would be used as a backup if there were roadworks etc on the normal 10mTT course WN10/01

Course/Event History: This course has been used regularly for over 5 years.
